WRITE-ON COMPETITION

A. Competition Dates

- The Write-on Competition will begin on Saturday, **May 16th, 2009** at **10 a.m. EST**, and end on Saturday **May 23rd, 2009** at **12 p.m. EST**.
- As soon as the Executive Board Editors of both publications have reviewed all submissions, *Nova Law Review* and/or *ILSA Journal* will extend invitations to those candidates who have displayed adequate bluebooking and writing skills, which are essential for the successful completion of either publication's summer training program. You must notify the publication of your decision to become a member by the deadline provided in the invitation(s). You may **only** accept membership to either *Nova Law Review* **or** *ILSA Journal*.

B. Eligibility to Compete

- Write-on competition participants must have a minimum cumulative **G.P.A. of 2.50** following the winter 2009 grade posting.
- A participant must have received an anonymous number via email, between the dates of **April 16, 2009** and **May 15, 2009**. A student wide email will be sent on April 16th informing you how to receive your anonymous number.

C. Write-on Packet

- The Write-on Packet will contain all the instructions and materials you need to participate in the competition. The packet will provide the subject matter of the paper, the permitted source materials, and instructions on how to successfully complete the paper.
- On **Saturday, May 16th, 2008, at 10 a.m. EST**, the Write-on Packet will become available for download on TWEN. As stated above, you **must** acquire an anonymous number before the above stated dates in order to download the packet. Information about how to download the packet will be sent via email prior to the competition.

D. Turning in Your Paper

- All procedures for handing in the competition paper are stated on the **first** page of the Write-On Packet. All papers must be submitted on TWEN before **12 p.m. EST Saturday, May 23rd**. If your paper is not submitted on TWEN before this time, you will lose your chance to participate in the write-on competition. There will be **no** exceptions.
- If for some reason you feel that you will not be able to turn in your paper through TWEN, you can turn in your paper in person. If you so choose, four **paper** copies of your competition paper must be handed in between **10 a.m.** and **12 p.m. EST** on **Saturday, May 23rd, 2009** on the upstairs bridge connecting the Law Library and Faculty areas in the Nova Law School Atrium. Two copies are submitted to *Nova Law Review* and two copies are submitted to *ILSA Journal*.
